Qualification of members. Membership in this Association shall consist of regular, honorary and associate members.

REGULAR MEMBERS:

1. SERVICE IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES: Any person who has served honorably in any of the Armed Forces of the United States, within Korea, or who served honorably without Korea (anywhere) from June 25, 1950 to January 31, 1955 shall be eligible for membership. No person shall be excluded from membership because of race, color, creed, sex, national or ethnic origin, sexual orientation, or physical or mental disability, so long as the individual meets the service requirements.
2. MEDAL OF HONOR. Any Medal of Honor recipient, so honored for service in Korea during the Korean War shall be eligible for life membership.
3. PRISONER OF WAR. Any person held as a prisoner of war by the North Koreans, Chinese, or Russian forces during and after the period of hostilities from June 25, 1950 forward shall be eligible for life membership.
4. GOLD STAR MOTHERS. Any woman whose son was killed in action, or was missing in action, or died as a prisoner of war during the Korean War shall be eligible for life membership.
5. GOLD STAR WIVES. Any woman whose husband was killed in action or was missing in action, or died as a prisoner of war during the Korean War shall be eligible for life membership.

HONORARY/ASSOCIATE MEMBERS:

1. Any person of good character may be elected as a member by the vote of the membership.
